The 1.5 day retreats will focus on both transferring the "financial business" *and* transferring the "management and responsibility" of the farm business. The workshop provides time for significant planning and discussion within the farm family. Individualized follow-up meetings will be offered to participants. The introductory one-day workshops will feature information on family communications, farm goal setting, business structures, mechanisms for transition, estate/gift taxes, mechanisms for inheritance, and basic concepts for retirement planning. Participants will also briefly learn about the FBM program and SCORE mentoring. The workshops will present complimentary content to the three 1.5 day retreats that are being offered.
